The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) has issued an Interim Final Rule (IFR) that removes the race- and sex-based presumptions of social and economic disadvantage from its Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program effective as of October 3, 2025.

Please be advised that all DBE goals set on federal projects in the October letting have been revised to **0%**. Due to the timing of this change, the bidding documents and electronic files will **not** be updated to reflect the revised goal. Contractors should proceed with the understanding that the DBE goal for these projects is 0%, regardless of what is shown in the bid documents.
