



**MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
NOTICE OF BID OPENING FOR PROPOSED STATE ROAD WORK
BIDS TO BE RECEIVED -- February 21, 2025**

BIDS FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS WILL BE RECEIVED ELECTRONICALLY BY THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION UNTIL 11:00A.M. (PREVAILING LOCAL TIME ON THE ABOVE DATE)

ALL BIDS SHALL BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY USING THE BIDEXPRESS WEBSITE. ANY PAPER BID SUBMITTED SHALL BE CONSIDERED IRREGULAR PER SECTION 102.3 OF THE MISSOURI STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION.

REFER TO SECTION 102 OF THE MISSOURI STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION FOR BID SUBMITTAL PROCEDURES.

EACH BID SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CERTIFIED CHECK OR CASHIER'S CHECK, DRAWN ON ANY BANK OR TRUST COMPANY AND PAYABLE TO "DIRECTOR OF REVENUE, CREDIT STATE ROAD FUND", OR BIDDERS MAY SUBMIT A BID BOND FOR EACH PROJECT BID OR AN ANNUAL BID BOND THAT WOULD COVER ALL PROJECTS BID FOR A TWELVE MONTH BEGINNING JULY 1 AND ENDING JUNE 30 OF EACH MISSOURI STATE FISCAL YEAR. ANNUAL BID BOND FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY JUNE 15 OF EACH YEAR. BID BONDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON A FORM FURNISHED BY THE COMMISSION, EXECUTED BY THE BIDDER AND CORPORATE SURETY, AND NAMING THE "STATE OF MISSOURI, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION", AS OBLIGEE) FOR AN AMOUNT (OR PENAL SUM) EQUAL TO 5% OR MORE OF THE BID, WHICH CHECK OR BOND SHALL BE DEPOSITED WITH THE COMMISSION AS A GUARANTY AND FORFEITED IN THE EVENT THE BIDDER IS FOUND TO BE THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER AND FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE REQUEST FOR BID. ON EXECUTION AND DELIVERY BY THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER OF THE CONTRACT, CONTRACT BOND, AND EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE PROTECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUEST FOR BID, SAID BIDDER'S CHECK OR BID BOND WILL BE RETURNED TO BIDDER; AND THE CHECKS OR BID BONDS OF THE UNSUCCESSFUL BIDDERS WILL BE RETURNED TO THEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE REQUEST FOR BID AND SECTION 227.100, RSMO.

THE BIDDER, TO WHOM THE CONTRACT FOR THE DOING OF THIS WORK MAY BE AWARDED, MUST EXECUTE THE CONTRACT FORM AND BOND FURNISHED BY THE COMMISSION.

PAYMENT WILL BE MADE SEMI-MONTHLY. PAYMENT SHOULD BE RECEIVED BY THE CONTRACTOR APPROXIMATELY FIFTEEN WORK DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH ESTIMATE PERIOD.

THE REQUEST FOR BID AND CONTRACT WILL CONTAIN PROVISIONS REQUIRING PAYMENT OF THE PREVAILING HOURLY RATE OF WAGES FOR EACH CRAFT OR TYPE OF WORKER REQUIRED TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS OF MISSOURI, AND A SCHEDULE OF MINIMUM WAGES AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR OF THE UNITED STATES ON ALL FEDERAL-AID PROJECTS.

THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION HEREBY NOTIFIES ALL BIDDERS THAT IT WILL AFFIRMATIVELY INSURE THAT IN ANY CONTRACT ENTERED INTO PURSUANT TO THIS ADVERTISEMENT, DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES WILL BE AFFORDED FULL OPPORTUNITY TO SUBMIT BIDS IN RESPONSE TO THIS INVITATION AND WILL NOT BE DISCRIMINATED AGAINST ON THE GROUNDS OF RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, CREED, SEX, AGE, ANCESTRY, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN IN CONSIDERATION FOR AN AWARD.

THE RIGHT IS RESERVED BY THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS.

ANY CONTRACTOR WHO DESIRES TO BID ON THE PROJECT(S) INVOLVED IN THE BID OPENING MUST HAVE A CONTRACTOR QUESTIONNAIRE ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AT LEAST SEVEN FULL DAYS (168 HOURS) PRIOR TO THE TIME OF BID OPENING. A NEW CONTRACTOR QUESTIONNAIRE MUST BE FILED ANNUALLY EXCEPT THAT THE COMMISSION MAY REQUEST A NEW QUESTIONNAIRE AT ANY TIME.

THE BIDDER SHALL CAREFULLY REVIEW THE PLANS, REQUEST FOR BID, AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS GOVERNING THE SECTION OR SECTIONS OF WORK ON WHICH THE BIDDER WISHES TO SUBMIT A BID. TO REPORT BID RIGGING ACTIVITIES CALL: 1-800-424-9071. THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT) OPERATES THE ABOVE TOLL-FREE "HOTLINE" MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. 8:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M., EASTERN TIME. ANYONE WITH KNOWLEDGE OF POSSIBLE BID RIGGING, BIDDER COLLUSION, OR OTHER FRAUDULENT ACTIVITIES SHOULD USE THE HOTLINE TO REPORT SUCH ACTIVITIES. *** NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS ***

SECTION 107.1 OF THE MISSOURI STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION STATES THAT THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBSERVE AND COMPLY WITH ALL FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS. YOUR ATTENTION IS CALLED TO SENATE BILL NO. 96, WHICH WAS PASSED BY THE 88TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR. THIS BILL REQUIRES THAT ALL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS WHERE TWENTY OR MORE PEOPLE ARE ENGAGED IN PERFORMANCE OF WORK, THE PRIMARY CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AT LEAST ONE PORTABLE TOILET FOR EACH TWENTY PEOPLE. THIS PROVISION SHALL BE ENFORCED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS THROUGH THE DIVISION OF LABOR STANDARDS. YOUR ATTENTION IS ALSO CALLED TO SECTIONS 285.525 and 285.530, RSMO, WHICH REQUIRE BUSINESS ENTITIES TO ENROLL AND PARTICIPATE IN A FEDERAL WORK AUTHORIZATION PROGRAM IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE AWARD OF ANY STATE CONTRACT IN EXCESS OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000).

MISSOURI LAW, 292.675 RSMO, REQUIRES THE AWARDED CONTRACTOR AND ITS SUBCONTRACTOR(S) TO PROVIDE A TEN-HOUR OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (OSHA) CONSTRUCTION SAFETY PROGRAM (OR A SIMILAR PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AS A QUALIFIED SUBSTITUTE) FOR THEIR ON-SITE EMPLOYEES (LABORERS, WORKMEN, DRIVERS, EQUIPMENT OPERATORS, AND CRAFTSMEN) WHO HAVE NOT PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED SUCH A PROGRAM AND ARE DIRECTLY ENGAGED IN ACTUAL CONSTRUCTION OF THE IMPROVEMENT (OR WORKING AT A NEARBY OR ADJACENT FACILITY USED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE IMPROVEMENT). PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE INCLUDE CONTRACTOR FORFEITURE TO THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500, PLUS \$100 PER CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR EMPLOYEE FOR EACH CALENDAR DAY SUCH EMPLOYEE IS EMPLOYED BEYOND THE ELAPSED TIME PERIOD FOR REQUIRED PROGRAM COMPLETION UNDER 292.675 RSMO.
